



CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE AGREEMENT

Clarity ADHD, PLLC | Lucas Craft, PA-C | Washington State

Purpose

This agreement helps make sure controlled substances are used safely.

It sets clear expectations for both you and your provider. Controlled substances prescribed at Clarity ADHD, PLLC are for your personal medical use only. They will be prescribed only as described in this agreement.

Your Responsibilities

- **One prescriber:** Get controlled substances from one provider at a time. If another provider prescribes them, tell Lucas Craft, PA-C right away.
- **Prescription monitoring:** You agree to let Lucas Craft, PA-C check the Washington State Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) before and during your treatment.
- **Take as prescribed:** Take your medication only as directed. Do not change your dose without talking to your provider first.
- **No sharing:** Do not sell, share, or give your medication to anyone else.
- **Safe storage:** Keep your medication in a secure place, away from children and others.
- **Lost, damaged, or stolen medication:** Lost, damaged, or stolen prescriptions will generally not be replaced early. Report theft to law enforcement and tell your provider right away.
- **Drug screening:** You may be asked to provide a urine drug screen at any time. Refusing or having results that do not match your prescription may lead to stopping your controlled substance prescription.
- **Be honest:** Tell your provider the truth about your symptoms, how your medication is working, side effects, and any concerns.

Provider Responsibilities

Lucas Craft, PA-C agrees to:

- Prescribe controlled substances only when clinically needed
- Explain the risks, benefits, and alternatives of any medication
- Monitor how you respond to treatment
- Check the WA State PMP before prescribing
- Treat you with respect and without judgment

When Prescriptions May Be Stopped

Controlled substance prescriptions may be changed or stopped for clinical reasons at any time.

The following actions may result in your prescription being stopped right away. They may also end your care at Clarity ADHD, PLLC. In some cases, they may require reporting to the appropriate authorities:

- Getting controlled substances from more than one provider without telling us
- Selling, sharing, or diverting your medication
- Forging or changing a prescription
- Giving false information about substance use, other current or past medications, or medical history
- Repeatedly missing follow-up appointments



- A pattern of early or unusual refill requests
- Drug screen results that do not match your prescribed or reported medications
